THE PROBLEM

"Dear Mr. Garlock:

I am experiencing some very rough times with Satan fighting me with rock music. I was the lead singer in a hard rock band for two years before I was saved. My whole life was centered on music. I would spend 4-8 hours listen-ing to a stereo-tape player and would get 'high' listening to hard rock and acid rock. I am at my wit's end, and am really having a hard struggle trying to rid myself of the effects of this music. Can you help me? "Dear Mr. Garlock:

I used to be a hippie and naturally I 'couldn't live' without rock. I never cared for acid rock unless I was or. drugs at the time. But even though I'm right with God now, and I love Him, when I hear rock I hear a little voice that says, 'Hey man, what do you mean you Love God! & You're missing all the fun! It's driving me crazy. You mentioned today that you had helped a girl who was having this same kind of trouble and that you would share this secret with us. Please do!" 'Dear Mr. Garlock

Two years ago I heard you speak, I laughed at you. Now I have become a miserable, confused Christian. My werst problem is that I don't know what my problem is. But I am going to explore the possibility that it might be rock. Please tell me how I

can quit rock and forget how much I like it. I would like to know how I can be a happy person. The thought of going on like this is unbearable

These three letters echo the thoughts of many, many teenagers with whom I have talked personally. They all have been involved with rock to one degree or another, and the devil is now using this tool which many people have thought was harmless as a weapon to completely defeat them in their Christian lives.

Is there an answer for these young people? Can they erase the music and lyrics of the world's music from their minds and hearts? Can they have victory over the world, the flesh, and the devil in spite of the lasting effects of this music? Can a teenager whose mind has been dominated by the devil's philosophy and music ever really be able to control his thoughts and live a life under the control of the Holy Spirit? The answer to all of these questions is an emphatic YES!

There are several basic

principles that we need to understand in order to face this problem squarely and give young people a key to victory in their spiritual

> "GARBAGE IN GARBAGE OUT'

The first principle is that a person's mind is only as good as the material which he allows it to feed on. Computer programmers put it this way: "Garbage in-garbage out." What they mean by this is that a computer is only as valid as the information which it is fed. If the programmer feeds it incorrect information, he will get incorrect information back out of it, and to a great degree, this is the way that the sub-conscious mind works. If a person allows his mind to the fed false information-through TV, ungodly profes-sors, rock music or any other (See Page 2)

THE A.C.E. Question

way-his thoughts, reactions and actions will unwittingly be guided by this information which has been stored in his sub-conscious mind. This is why so many Christian young people are completely de-feated in their Christian lives. They have allowed the world and the devil to completely brainwash them, mainly through rock music so that they accept carnal so that they accept carnal standards of dress, the world's ideas of love, peace, and happiness, and the devil's philosophy of right and wrong. And many Christian parents have been duped into thinking that the world's music can't hurt their children. 1 am thoroughly weary of hearing parents say, "I can't control what my children listen to." They had better control it, or wake up some day to find that the devil has trapped their children while they have stood idly by and watched it

happen.
This principle helps us to understand why the Word of God is so explicit in telling us what we should allow our minds to dwell on. For instance, Phillipians 4:8 says that we should make things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, virtuous, and praiseworthy the center focus of our attention, and "think on these things." God also warns us that as a man "thinketh in his heart, so is he " (Prov. 23:7). Have you ever noticed how often the Bible links what we think in our minds with our spirituality. Listen to these scriptures: "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose MIND is stayed on thee" (Is. 26:3); "Let this MIND be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus" (Phil 2:5); "Be not conformed to world: but be ye formed by the renewing transformed by the renewing of your MIND"(Rom. 12:2); and "For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace"(Rom 8:6). The only way for a young person to gain victory is to learn to subject his mind to the Spirit of God and to strive to keep himself from being brain-washed by the devil. "But," I can hear a

I can hear a teenager say, "we're sur-rounded by this kind of stuff. How do you get away from rock music in this genera-' And this is a problem! I believe success is possible if we work at it. To begin with, make a covenant with God that you will deliberately try to avoid it wherever and whenever possible. The apostle Paul said. make not provision for the flesh" (Rom. 13:14), and this includes trying to avoid the temptation as much as possible. In other words, whenever you are in control of the situation, don't allow rock. Don't possess any records, don't listen to it on your radio, turn off the TV when the background music uses rock (it might not be a bad idea to turn off the TV anyway), and keep it out of your life as much as possible. The same kind of thinking is needed regarding porno-graphy. We are surrounded

by it, but we avoid and speak out against it wherever we can. And just as we control what we allow our eves to we should control what we allow our ears to hear.
A SOUND MIND

The second principle is to realize that God wants us to have a sound mind. The aging apostle Paul told young Timothy that "God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a SOUND MIND" (II Tim. 1:7) God does not want us to fear. I have yet to talk to a teenager who liked rock music who did not express fear in one way or another. Fear is of the devil, and he has used rock music to incite ungodly fear into his followers. But a Christian should not fear, unless he is holding something out from God. Incomplete surrender causes fear in the heart of a Christian. The devil's children use alcohol, drugs and rock music to hide from their fear. And while many Christteenagers do not use alcohol or drugs, they do use the rock music for the same purpose. But this kind of "escape" from fear never brings release. It only brings further bondage, because thinking straight, and prevents him from having the sound mind which God wants him to have. This is why it is so difficult to try to reason with a person who is out of the will of God, or is holding out on God. A person who is

II Corinthians 10:1-3 sheds some interesting light on this when it says about the battle that we fight against the devil: "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds;) Casting down imagniation, EVERY high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, AND BRINGING INTO CAPTIV-ITY EVERY THOUGHT TO THE OBEDIENCE OF CHRIST." This should be the goal of every Christian teenager: to 1. recognize that the battle is a spiritual one, 2. to be opposed to everything that opposes itself to God and that opposes useft to God and Christ-like living, and 3. to make a "prisoner" of each of our thoughts, making sure that we are thinking as Christ would have us think

afraid to fully surrender his life and his all to God never

is able to think clearly, since fear prohibits sound thinking.

Any honest teenager will admit that one of the biggest battles he has is in the area of his thought life. It is often right here that the battle against the devil is either won or lost. And it is here that the devil has used his most subtle tool, music, to infiltrate "the counsel of the ungodly" into the thinking processes of even the Biblebelieving Christians, espe-cially those "lukewarm." middle-of-the-road Christians mentioned in Revelation 3:15-16. Because these people are "neither cold nor hot," neither sold out to the world nor to God, they cannot see

the difference between right and wrong or good and bad, and even God is nauseated by them. No wonder they can't stand themselves

SOMETHING BETTER

"O.K., then," says teenager, "what can I listen to? If I reject the world's music do I have to sit around all day and listen to hymns? After all, music is a big part of my life." And this brings us to the very important third principle: whenever you take something away from yourself, you must replace it with something better. leave yourself with a vac-uum! It's not enough to just have a list of taboos without positive things to replace those things which are eliminated from the life A starving man will eat out of a garbage can simply because there is nothing else to be found. But once a juicy steak is placed in front of him, the garbage loses its appeal. There are many "Starving" Christians who have gone to the devil's garbage can to try to salvage something good out of the Satanic slop because they have not tasted of the spiritual steak which God offers to every Christian who is willing to take the time and make the effort necessary to find and chew this "strong meat" that belongs to those who are becoming mature (Heb. 5:14)

For teenagers who are really interested, I will wrtie a future article for this paper on the art of Bible meditation. A young person who learns how to meditate in the Word of God has equipped himself with the skill necessary to use the Sword of the Spirit in an effective way and can thus have personal victory for his own mind and heart.

The fascinating thing is how the Holy Spirit connects this process of meditation music. For instance, with at what Ephesians 5:18-19 lists as the automatic result of being filled with the "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." The natural result of the control of the Holy Spirit in a person's life is MUSIC. But this scripture gives that music definite qualifications: scriptural words that bring praise to God and lift the spirit of man, and music that based primarily 'melody.'

The parallel scripture to Ephesians 5:18-19 is just as fascinating in that it gives almost exactly the same qualifications to music that is a result of the filling of the Word of God: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." BY JIM JONES THE FUNERAL OF A CHURCH

The oldest Christian congregation in Newton, Massachusetts, (and one of the oldest in our United States) established in 1664, has disbanded and sold its church property to another congregation. The First Church in Newton is affiliated with the Massachusetts Conference of the United Church of Christ. The church attained a membership peak of 1,210 members in 1952 but since that time membership has steadily declined. More than 75 percent of the church's membership was above 50 years of age. Efforts had been made during the past ten years of the church's existence to merge with other U.C.C. congregations but these had failed. This fact, together with the increasing cost of maintaining the church property and buildings led to this decision.

While it is sad to see one of the earliest church's of our nation's history close its doors, we feel that a church which has forsaken its Godgiven message (the proclamation of the glorious Gospel) and has lost sight of the church's purpose in the world



tion of the saints of God through the faithful proclamation of the Word of God) has no reason which justifies its existence. Let me suggest failures in these vital matters as better reasons for locking church doors than rising maintenance costs or declin ing attendance. Sadder still than the notorious funeral of a historic church is the multitude of churches across the continent which are totally dead and echo this funeral dirge but have not yet been buried. A Hollywood film company is currently bargaining with Fleming Revue Company for the movie rights to the recently published novel by Marjorie Holmes entitled, TWO FROM GALILEE. This work is reportedly a love story of Mary and Joseph, the greatest love story of all time-told for the first time as a love story. One reviewer of the novel has commented that 'Christ's birth is too awesome an event, too deep a mystery, too joyful a happening to be

fitted into a twentieth century love story mold." Again, the reviewer comments: "In trying to create a 'grand passion' between Mary and Joseph, the author shifts the focus from Christ to fallen man." What-ever the intent of the writer of TWO FROM GALILEE apart from a desire to portray a dramatic love story, one shudders to think of what Hollywood will do with the novel of Miss Holmes. Revue declares that Miss Holmes has told the story "without depart-ing from a Scriptural base." It is certain that Hollywood's portrayal of the momentous event of Christ's birth and event of Christ's birth and events surrounding it, will be related, in typical fashion, with an eye to box office appeal rather than Scriptural accuracy. committee or the central committee was a modernist false religionist. I as a Bible believing fundamental-ist would have to refuse cooperation with it. I would do this on Bible grounds of separation according to II Corinthians 6:14,17 and many other passages. There are many of these liberals on the executive and central committees including the National Council of Churches evangelism committee. What creates the big problem is that there are many others on this committee who do believe the Bible and do understand true evangelism. Consequently, thousands are going to be talking Christ and evangelism with almost as many different ideas as to what it means as there are those talking.

On page 197 of the Key '73 Congregational Resource Book (the handbook for cooperating congregations, hereafter referred to as the Resource Book), Rev. Wesley Smedes in an article on the rules of the game says,"The simultaneous and concurrent rule means a large number of participants will be involved in an aggressive outreach at the same time. All will be carrying the banner of Key '73 and each will be doing 'its own thing.' This rule has distinct advantages. Every group identified with Key '73 will be able to take advantage of the general publicity.
With all the groups and
denominations doing their thing at the same time, more levels or strata of American society may be confronted with the gospel. One group with its God-given gifts may with its God-given gitts may be more skilled at playing on one field of action than another. Where one cannot play as well, another will be more adept." I think you can see how this parallels the confusion of tongues at Babel. For instance, there are many excellent statements and some good articles in the Resource Book. Yet when you turn the page, you read clear statements that reek with the social gospel of the liberal Dr. G.H.S. Phibodeaux, the General Sec-retary of Evangelism, Afri-

Methodist Church (a National Council Church) says in an article on Church) says in an article on page 176 of the Resource Book, "It has been said 'you can't change nature by nuture.' Nuture can only dress things up while nature remains the same in its crudest moments. One may dreer a ping manique its crudest moments. dress a pig, manicure its hoofs, even put a pink ribbon around its neck, but when the pig sees a mudhole, the matter of dressing up is wasted, By nature it prefers mudholes. The change in men also become effective only through the power of the new birth. When a man is reborn, he becomes a new creature in Christ." He tempers this statement somewhat with his next remarks however. Dr George Outen in his presentation of Key '73 to the liberal United Methodist Conference in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 25, 1972 said, "To protest war-that's evangelism. To work for open housing-that's evangelism. To combat racism-that's evangelism. To be engaged in the political process that, too, is evangel-ism." Dr. Outen is opposed to a "Bible thumping revival-ist" kind of evangelism. These quotations are enough to show you the confusion that will be generated by Key

its clear ecumenical leanings our name will be ''mud.' Who gets hurt?-the fundamentalists, the true evangelical church.


WHO'S MISSING IN KEY

Omissions in a list of churches and organizations are as important as the are as important as the inclusions. You would think that if a program of evangelism is good, Biblical and true, it would include those who have been active in soul winning and in the forefront of evangelism forefront of evangelism through the years. For instance, the largest soul winning churches in North America are independent Baptist Churches belonging to fellowships of churches such as the Bible Baptist Fellowship, the General Association of Regular Baptist. the World Baptist Fellowship. the Conversative Baptist Fellowship and the Independent Fundamental Churches of America. None of these are listed as participants-there must be a reason. Nationwide fundamental mission boards such as Baptist Mid-Missions, Baptist International Missions, and many non--denominational other missions are missing from the list. Great men of God who have held the truth of Bible evangelism high through the years are missing from the list such as Dr. Lee Roberson of Tennessee Temple Schools, Dr. Bob Jones of Bob Jones Univer-sity, Dr. Jack Hiles of the First Baptist Church, Hammond, Indiana, Dr. Oliver Greene of the Gospel Hour, Dr. John R. Rice of the Sword of the Lord Foundation who has held as many or more soul winning confer-ences than any man alive and Dr. Ford Potter whose tract has won thousands. There must be some reason why these men are not officially a part of Key '73.

It's In The Book!

Most students and unfortunately many teachers have a belief that if something is in print (particularly in a textbook) it must be true. For a teacher to disagree with the author of the text would be unheard of in public schools, and if a disagreement were to be noted, both teacher and student would go to that unerring source of knowledge (the encyclopedia) to see who is telling the truth.

Dr. Stuart Crane, in the January, 1973 edition of The PROJECTOR, gives a definition of "Truth" as follows:
"Truth is an accurate representation of that which is under consideration and its relationship to all other things as it always has been in the past, is universally in the present, and shall hold without exception in the future." Now, if this definition is accurate, anything less than this is error. Therefore, we can conclude that almost every thing in textbooks, and most especially the encyclopedia, is

error.
All fundamentalists agree that science and biology books contain many errors but these same people find it difficult to believe that a civics or history book is full of error. History books probably contain more error than any other type of textbook.

The script to a filmstrip titled "New Education Order or Chaos" has been inserted in the Congressional Record on July 16, 1971. In this script the subject of "destroying his-tory" is discussed as follows:

"Men like Rousseau who use fraud to destroy the minds of children must destroy history,

because if children know history they will never fall for the propaganda of the elite philosopher kings. History is destroyed in two ways. First, they minimize history; se-cond, they distort history for their own purposes. So Roustheir own purposes. so rousseau joined with Voltaire, Diderot, and d'Alembert to re-write the history of the world. They called themselves "The Encyclopedists'."
There is another false idea

among many Christians con-cerning books and publishers. Many believe that a book such as "None Dare Call It Conspiracy", published by a relatively unknown company, contains less truth than a book on the same subject published by a well known company. There is no basis for this type of reasoning. As a matter of fact, just the opposite conclu-sion makes more sense. If "None Dare Call It Conspriacy" is factual in exposing a conspiracy which is made up of the elite in banking and academicians (including the major publishing companies) the major publishers would certainly not publish a book exposing themselves. If, however, the book is false, any publisher would be glad to reap the profits from a book which has sold over 5 million

Christian teachers have an obligation to teach students that all information in the textbook must be seen in the light of THE BOOK, God's Word. Jesus said that He is Truth. He who knows Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior is able to have truth revealed to him. Without Christ, truth is impossible.

A recent editorial in the Los Angeles Times reported that:

"The biggest untild story in American education today is a great revolution that is at least a quarter of a century old. It is the growth of private schools of inany types and purposes in all parts of the nation." A 1969 Gallop Poll revealed that "sixty-five percent of those questioned felt private schools were equal or superior in quality to public schools." (Most Christian schools range from three months to eighteen mouths ahead of the national achievement test norm). "Even more astroishing, 59% asserted that they would send their children to nonpublic schools if tuition were free."

The American people in general and

The American people in general and the Christian community in particular are losing faith in the government school system for a variety of reasons.

PERVERSION AND THE OCCULT

Recent issues of the San Francisco Chronicle document the following:

"Constitutional Law classes at Berkelev (CA) High School were the setting for student view-ing of explicit, no-holds-barred, pornographic films. The subject matter was relevant to the obscenity issues that the classes were studying."

Ninth grade world history at Redwood High School in Larkspur, California, according to Gene Ragel of Roseville, "turned into a com-plete course in copulation within three weeks."

Family Life Education classes at Roosevelt Junior High School in San Francisco (CA) has been criticized by Mr. Ragel also for utilizing homosexual speakers. These speakers appeared at the school as part of a ninth grade ecology class experiment in sex education."

In October, a letter to the editor of Columbus (Ohio) Evening Dispatch was written as follows:

"We are writing in response to an incident which occurred in humanities class at Upper Arlington High School on Friday, Oct. 13.

A GUEST speaker spoke to the class on witch-craft and proceeded to show her "powers" by performing in front of the class and asking for student participation. Many students responded favorably."

VIOLENCE AND NARCOTICS

Dr. Max Rafferty in his new book, Classroom Countdown, says,

"In several of our hig-city schools, policemen have to be stationed in the corridors in order to protect the teacher from his pupils, and the pupils from each other."

The Los Angeles City Schools have recently appropriated \$180,000 to hire "safety aids" to patrol the halls, restrooms and playgrounds of the L.A. City Schools Schools.

Last week 1 interviewed for my daily radio program, Christian School Com-ment, a pastor from New York City, Among the many disturbing things he told me was the fact that 50% of all the high school students and 30% of the elementary students in New York City are on

drugs of some kind. He said that some of the girls from his church who attend the public schools are afraid to go into the girls restrooms the full day they are in school because of the potential violence. These and other factors prompted this pastor to establish New York Christian Academy in his church. The school already has more than two hundred students.

LOW ACADEMICS

Parents are disenchanted with government schools because of low academic standards. Dr. John R. Miles, writing in the new quarterly edition of the Saturday Evening Post (Spring 1972) said:

evening rost (Spring 1942) said:
"The nation's number one academic problem in
ducation today is a reading problem. The U.S.
Office of Education has estimated, "There are
4 million people eighteen years old or older in
the United States who are functionally
literate."

"That means they cannot read, write, or count well enough to handle the day-to-day tasks demanded of them in modern society; they cannot read well enough to know what bus to take to get to work, they cannot count the streets or read the street signs well enough to know when to get off the bus and transfer to another. Yet it isn't because they haven't gone to school. There are only 6.4 million Americans fourteen years old and over who haven't gone through at least the fifth grade. So the inescapable conclusion is that the vast majority of those 24 million functionally illiterate' people had gone to school for at least five years but learned little except to hate school."

Last week, the Los Angeles Herald Examiner editorialized that the state of California has now eliminated all specified 'That means they cannot read, write, or count

California has now eliminated all specified academic requirements for High School graduation. Dr. Calvin Grieder, writing in The Nation's Schools said:

The validity of standards is apparent in so many aspects of life in these United States. In academic affairs I see this every day in the widespread abolition of grades, examinations, and attendance requirements."

HIGH COST

Americans are losing faith in their public schools because of the high cost of financing them. President Nixon said re-

cently,
"This nation is spending more money without corresponding results in education than any other country in history: some \$60 to \$70 billions a year goes into the public school systems – as much as the rest of the world together – and every year the school system turns out tens of thousands of high school graduates who can't read the diplomas they're handed."

Governor Reagan said last spring at the National Association of Secondary School principals in Anaheim (CA),

"In California, the total enrollment growth in grades kindergarten through twelve has been only 7.2% over the past six budget years. Yet, the state alone has increased its support for

kindergarten through twelve by 45% in that same period." He said, "The public asks why more and more money is needed to educate fewer and fewer children."

LOSING CONTROL

Parents are losing faith in the public schools because they are losing control of them. In the last decade there has been a decline in public school boards throughout the country from twenty-five thousand to eighteen thousand school

CHANGE AGENTS

Parents are losing faith in the govern-ment schools because they are embarking on a course for which they were never intended – change agents.

In an article titled "Forecast For The

70's," the National Education Association Journal observed in its issue for January

1969, "The roles and responsibilities of teachers will alter throughout the next decade. Future-think suggests that between 1970 and 1980 a number of new assignments and specialities will materialize if present trends continue. For one thing, the basic role of the teacher will change noticeably. Ten years hence it should be more accurate to term him a "learning clinician." This title is intended to convey the idea that schools are becoming "clinics" whose purpose is to provide individualized psycho-social "treatment" for the student."

Many of the government sponsored "alternative schools" are already heavily bent in the direction of "unfreezing old beliefs and attitudes and moving to new socially relevant concepts." The Minneapolis Tribune says of the students from one of these schools.

one of tness schools, "Probably the most serious development is that some of the students have become worsted about whether they are learning basic skills and normal school subjects... they are at a point where they want skilled teachers rather than groovy relators."

Max Rafferty spoke volumes when he

'A school is neither a health resort, a recreation center, nor a psychiatric clinic. It's a place where the massed wisdom of the ages is passed from one generation to the next, and where youngsters are taught to think in a logical and systematic fashion. A school where subject disciplines are unimportant is a school where education itself has become irrelevant."

Christian schools are flourishing because they are an effort to bring back some 'normalcy' to the process of education. They provide an education where Christ is honored and the teachings of God's word are freely shared with a generation of youngsters who are reaching out for light in a very dark world.

VISIT TO A.C.E. SCHOOL

In December of 1972, while attending a meeting of The American Association of Christian Schools in Dallas, Texas, I asked the principal of a local Christian school if he would make arrangements for would make arrangements for myself and several other principals, also attending the A.A.C.S. meeting, to visit the A.C.E. pilot school which is operated in Garland, Texas. These arrangements were made with Dr. Howard and we rooms of the pilot school. I expressed to Dr. Howard again at that time my concern about the program. After seeing the program in action, I became more convinced than ever that the cause of Christian Education is going to be hurt if the program spreads throughout the counspreads throughout the country. Already reports are beginning to come in from principals and pastors dismayed with the program, and numbers of these schools have been in operation less than a year. Costs for consumable materials are running as high as \$1,500 per year per class above estimated expenditure in some instances. One pastor has been asked to take over a school started in his church last year by a group of parents. Another school that introduced the A.C.E. program into the 6th and 7th grades has already discarded it. The reports are only beginning to come in.

POSSIBLE EFFECT OF A.C.E.

There is no such thing as an easy way to have a Christian School. The devil hates Christian Education and you can be sure he will fight to discredit it all over this country. I predict that some communities will be so injured by the ill effects brought about by the failure of the A.C.E. program in their area, that it will take years to resell them on the right kind of Christian Education. The devil will use it to discredit the good Christian schools and many will some to receive the control of the co will come to associate Christ ian Education with the A.C.E. program. Pastors will lose the confidence of their people, in some cases, because they led them into this program.

WHAT IS THE ANSWER

I'm fully convinced that every community needs a Christian School. I am also convinced that God desires for every community to have a Christian School. There is a right way to do it, but it is not an easy way. It will take sacrifice, dedication, and real determination but it can be done. The first step is EARNEST PRAYER to God. With Mother's Day just around the corner an art project that would make a worthwhile gift may be a good thing on which to focus our attention. Attractive cards can be made on card stock with a BOLD design outlined and filled in with crayon that is melted over a candle flame. This soft crayon gives a very textured appearance that almost looks like thick oil paint. A nice personal message written by the child is placed on the inside. Large flowers, pieces of fruit or animals are suggestions for designs. This idea has been effectively used in all the elementary grades.

Another interesting gift for older children is to make a picture again choosing a hold design for the subject. For a very finished looking picture use a fabric background. Cover

a piece of cardboard that would fit into a standard sized picture frame with a solid colored material. A rough texture such as burlap makes an appropriate material for the background. The children make a pattern of their chosen design on plain white news-print and this may be transferred onto the background fabric with carbon or transfer paper. The yarn will outline and fill in the bold design by beginning the yarn on the outside edges and working toward the center. Interesting designs can be made with a large area by the direction in which the yarn goes. Different shades of color add variety and depth. These pictures can be framed and mothers will be proud to use them for wall decorations at home.



'Be Ye Separate'

Then, too, how many a Christian, hoping to make money, has gone into partner-ship with an unsaved man in some business venture, soon to find that he has put himself under an unequal yoke? That unsaved man feels perfectly free to do many things in business that a conscientious Christian cannot. He either has to stand against his partner or go with him; and if he does the latter, he will lose his Christian

testimony.

The same thing occurs in connection with association with all kinds of societies. Two scriptures should keep us out of them all. The first is this: Jesus said, "In secret have I said nothing." Therefore He could not have been a member of any secret society or lodge.

The other scripture, that already referred to, is: "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers." In these

Orders there are saved and unsaved people, and if we want to have a bright testimony for Christ, we must walk apart from that unequal yoke. Paul's reference is to that Old Testament scripture: "Thou shalt not plow with an ox and an ass yoked together." The ox was a clean beast and could be offered to God in sacrifice. The ass was looked upon as ceremonially unclean, and the two were not to be yoked together.

scripture is calling for is the desire and the power to write and perform music that meets the standards of the Word of God, and thus is a reflection of the Christian character that God expects of every born-again Christian.

THE PRINCIPLE OF A NEW SONG

King David said that God had put "a new song in his mouth, even praise unto our God" (Psalm 40:3). Why the necessity of a new song? To replace the old song that had been there when David was out of fellowship with the Lord, and to give God's servant the opportunity to bring others into the same relationship with the Lord that he had found: "Many shall see it and fear, and shall trust in the Lord." A Christian who is still singing the world's song is never a good testimony of the trans-forming power of the grace of God. His lack of complete surrender causes him to be a stumblingblock to those who are looking for a good, clear example of Christianity. The world looks at "rock Christians" as phonies and hypocrites and wonders why they don't live what they claim to

But there's something else that the new song does. It drives away the old one, and greatly diminshes, and sometimes even completely annuls, the power of the devil. Let's look at a Bible example. When the young shepherd boy David played his harp and sang for King Saul as recorded in I Samuel 16:23, "the evil spirit depart-ed from him." What a tremendous way to drive away the devil-with a song. But notice what the content of the song must be if it is going to do the job. It must be "praise unto God" (Psalm 40:3). Man's ideas and emotions and feelings will not do the trick. The devil is too clever to ever be defeated by a mere man, but the song of praise based on the Word of God can be used by a mere man to put the devil to flight. God has given us a beautiful way to defeat the forces of evil and gain victory in our personal lives if we will but apply the principle of a new

There is one more exciting thing that I must share with you. God's principle of a new song not only allows our minds to feed on good things, and gives us a sound mind. and replaces the world's song with something better, and drives the devil into hiding, but it also brings the power of God into a person's life in a way which he never before realized could be possible.

Remember, Psalm 40:3 said that when we sing this said that when we sing this new song, "many shall see it and fear, and shall trust in the Lord." Watch this principle work in real life! Paul and Silas are in the Philippian jail because of their testimony for the Lord Auts 18. Are they defeated? (Acts 16). Are they defeated? Absolutely not! They have something at their disposal which can not only change their own hearts and at-titudes, but it can affect the lives of others by completely altering the circumstances Verse 25 tells how they used the principle of a new song to transform themselves and everything around them: "And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God." What?! With their feet in stocks? And at midnight besides?! Yes, in the worst of circumstances they could sing their new song, because this song is not dependent upon circum-stances. It derives its melody from the relationship of the singer to the only One Who can give this kind of song-God Himself.

VICTORY

And when God joins in the singing, things really begin to snings, things reary begin to happen. There is a great earthquake, the prison doors are opened wide, the shackles are loosed, and a pagan jailer and his whole family find eternal life in Jesus Christ. And for the teenager who learns this secret; there are just as many miracles waiting to happen. The place which has seemed like a rison can become a place of blessing; the shackles of sin which bind him to himself and the world can be loosed so that he is free to live and walk in a whole new realm of spiritual power; and his friends will sense the power of the change that has come over his life so that they will want what he has found.

What are you waiting for? Start memorizing songs like "To God Be the Glory," "And Can It Be?," "Thank You, Jesus, For All You've Done, "All Hail the Power of Jesus'
Name," "How Great Thou art." "Thou Wilt Keep Him in Perfect Peace," "O For a Thousand Tongues," "Blessed Assurance," or the hundreds of other songs and hymns that are wonderful expressions of praise to the Lord. In fact, each of us should have a whole repertoire of these "new songs" to use against the devil, to chase away the blues, to give us spiritual confidence, or just to thrill our own hearts with the knowledge that God is in complete control of our lives, and that he will give us exactly what we need in any given situation.

And the best songs are

either paraphrases of scrip-ture or are so full of scripture that the process of singing them to yourself over and over actually causes you to be "meditating" in the Word of God. What a practical way of fulfilling the command of Deuteronomy 6:6-7-"And these words which I com-mand thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up." By when thou risest up. By singing the very words of scripture, we can utilize a great deal of what is ordinarily idle time to internalize the principles of God's wisdom so that our responses to the problems of life will be completely in line with the will of God for each of our lives.

Would you like to read what happened to one teenager who tried this principle? First, go back and read the third letter at the beginning of this article. Then read this letter which was written exactly one month later by the same teenager:

"Dear Mr. Garlock:..
I just wish I had time to tell you everything that has happened in these past days. So much about me has changed. I am learning to long for God's best in my life. I am learning to love His Word and to openly pour out my heart to Him. I am learning to accept myself and to love others. I am learning! I think for the first time in years I can say I am truly happy. God can really make things happen."

And God can make things happen in your life too if you will practice the principle of THE NEW SONG! "I will sing unto the Lord as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the Lord"(Psalm 104:33-34). The song of praise to God will sweeten our lives, and lead us into an exciting new relationship with our wonder-ful Lord Who has given us the heavenly gift of A NEW SONG.
